These six-week programs are designed for students who are working professionals with at least a master's degree in counseling, psychology, social work, occupational therapy, and speech therapy. The program includes both contact and non-contact hours. Live instruction is via Zoom meetings and non-contact instruction is through Desire 2 Learn (D2L). As participants, you will have access to our list of APT approved supervisors who work with you remotely toward your RPT/SB-RPT credential. Each course meets "virtually" for one hour weekly, with about two hours of work required weekly outside of class. Each class provides six hours of contact CEs and 12 hours of non-contact CEs. Introduction to Play Therapy

April 15 - May 20 Zoom meeting, Thursdays, 4 - 5 p.m., [HTH A51, CRN 40100], 18 CE hours, fee: \$365

If you're unsure what the term "play therapy" means, then this course is for you! This weekly virtual class with live meetings gives participants a core understanding of play therapy and how it can be applied in various settings and populations. Explore the history of play therapy and the core components of being a culturally competent play therapist. Practice interventions aimed at accelerating the cognitive and social-emotional growth of children and adolescents. The program is a combination of Desire to Learn (D2L) and Zoom.

Learning Objectives:

- · Examine directive and non-directive play therapy
- Participate in specific interventions which can be applied to individual, group, and family play therapy
- Evaluate cultural considerations in play therapy
- · Discuss the historical context behind play therapy
- · Examine approved toys to use in child-centered play therapy sessions
- · Analyze ways to set up a playroom in a variety of settings

Building Social-Emotional Learning Skills through Directive Play Therapy April 15 - May 20 Zoom meeting, Thursdays, 5 - 6 p.m., [HTH A64, CRN 40101], 18 CE hours, fee: \$365

Thinking about ways to increase social-emotional skills for all students? This weekly virtual class with live meetings increases social-emotional literacy skills in children of all ages through the combination of children's books and playbased interventions. Learn to create play therapy treatment plans that involve the therapist, teacher, and parent as a team and how to document and track progress throughout treatment. Learn practical ways to overcome the resistance of play therapy in the school setting and how to build alliances with teachers and administrators to implement play-based bibliotherapy programs. This program is a combination of Desire to Learn (D2L) and Zoom.

Learning Objectives:

- Identify findings in research and literature regarding bibliotherapy and social-emotional literacy training and how they relate to play therapy practices
- Implement play therapy-based interventions based on children's literature and programming within the school and private practice settings
- Identify children's literature/books that can be used in play therapy practice and how to effectively teach emotional literacy through the use of the books
- Examine practices based in multi-systemic play therapy programming (therapy, home, and school-focused) aimed at improving outcomes and increasing skill generalization

Continuing Education clock/contact hours will be offered for social workers, professional counselors, marriage and family therapists, psychologists, addictions counselors, ICB members, occupational therapists, and speech and language pathologists/audiologists. Association of Play Therapy CEs only offered to mental health professionals.

Participants will receive Zoom log-in information and instructions via email 24 hours prior to the program start date.
